

THINGS TO SEE & DO

There are loads of things to do on the island and we have only just discovered a few. Here are a few pointers. Numbers correspond to those on the map.

1 MAHON

Lovely city to wander around, have something to eat and just enjoy the atmosphere. The famous Xoriguer Gin Distillery is here and can be visited. From the house turn left on the main road, cross straight over the roundabout and you will be in the Marina. Park along here if you can and then walk along the water's edge and access the city from here. It is a real labyrinth so best to get in on foot from the Marina.

2 FAR DE FAVARITX

Lighthouse set in a lunar landscape. Only about 15 mins from the house.

3 ES GRAU

Shallow beach with restaurants and bars. Kayaks and SUPs for rent. Lovely juice shack on the way in on the right.



4 SA MESQUIDA

Quiet cove with sandy beach. Nudist at one end. Nice drive over to it. It has a very calm bay just before the beach.

5 ES CASTELL

Old fishing village just East of Mahon. Lovely restaurants on the water in a picturesque setting.

6 ALCAUFAR

Super quiet cove with a small sandy beach. Nice bar there too.



7 BINIBEQUER

Great beach with a fantastic chiringuito (beach bar) called Los Bucaneros. Worth going to Binibeca village next door which was built in the 70s to look like a Greek island.

8 CALA'N PORTER

We have not been but hear the village is nothing special but the famous restaurant/bar/music venue Cova d'en Xoroi is here. Built into the cliff it offers fantastic place for sundowners

9 SON BOU

Again, we have not been but this is the island's largest sandy beach.



10 CALA GALDANA

Famous small and beautiful sandy cove.

11 CALA MACARELLA & MACARELLETA

Idilic sandy coves with picture postcard blue water. A bit of a trek but well worth it. Large chiringuito here.



12 CALA TURQUETA

Another of the more famous coves in Menorca.

13 CIUTADELLA

Old capital of the island. Lovely marina and characterful medieval streets dotted with nice places to stop for a bite and refreshments.

14 MONTE TORO

The highest point and only mountain on the island. 360 degree views of the whole island. A fantastic bike ride if you are feeling brave as the ramps at the top are up to 22%. Cycle along the Cami d'en Kane to get here.

15 FORNELLS

Old fishing village popular for its water sports. You can hire all sorts of kit here. Nice bay and restaurants too.

16 CAMI D'EN KANE

The original road that connected the end of the island. Typical Menorcan stone walls with olive wood gates line the picturesque road. Great to cycle along and the start of it is moments away from the house.
